Newsletter Regulations

1. Discount code does not apply to promotions, discounts and services, and discounts do not combine,
2. To take advantage of the promotional offer, sign up for our newsletter and confirm your desire to receive news with the best deals; You will be redirected to the website with the discount code,
3. The code is one-time and assigned to your email address,
4. During your next purchases, you can use the newly received code!
5. to unsubscribe from the Newsletter, go to the footer of the email you received from us and click on the link at the very bottom. You can also write us an email asking us to unsubscribe your email address from our database.
6. The administrator of the data is Sklepy Komfort S.A. based in Lodz, 14 Srebrzyńska Street, 91-074 Lodz, e-mail: odo@komfort.pl entered in the National Court Register under number 267428, whose registration files are kept by the District Court for Łódź - Śródmieście in Łódź, XX Commercial Department of the National Court Register, share capital of PLN 85,418,228.14, NIP 851-299-15-93.
7. I have the right to access my data, correct them, demand their deletion, the right to limit processing, object to the processing of my personal data and the right to transfer my data. I have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection if my data is processed in violation of legal requirements.
8. The data will be processed for marketing purposes consisting of sending me newsletters containing information about products sold by the Administrator, the Administrator itself, promotions and promotional events, as well as analyzing whether I read newsletters from the Administrator and which content I read most often.
9. Providing data is voluntary. I do not have to fill out the form, however, without providing my email address I will not be able to receive the Newsletter.
10. The legal basis for the processing of my data is Article 6(1)(f) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27.04.2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC. The Administrator's legitimate interest is to conduct marketing, including improving the Newsletter by analyzing whether I read the Newsletter and which news I am most interested in.
11. The legal bases are also Article 10 of the Act of 18.07.2002 on the provision of electronic services and Article 172 of the Act of 16.07.2004. Telecommunications Law. Recipients of personal data will be:
 - a. Providers of tools for analyzing website traffic, conducting marketing, sending newsletters,
 - b. Entities hosting (storing) personal data for the Administrator.
12. My data will be transferred to countries outside the European Economic Area, i.e. to the United States on the basis of the Executive Decision of the European Commission of 12.07.2016 introducing the Privacy Shield.
13. Data will be transferred only to entities certified under this decision, which obliges them to properly secure my personal data. I will have the right to receive a copy of my personal data that will be transferred to such a country. Personal data will be processed for the duration of the Administrator's marketing activities in the form of sending newsletters, or until you object to further processing for marketing purposes or revoke your consent to sending messages to your e-mail address. Your revocation of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing prior to the withdrawal of consent.

KOMFORT

14. I have the right to object to the processing of my personal data by the Administrator for direct marketing purposes. I may object in any case. I also have the right to object when my data is processed on the basis of other legitimate interests. Such an objection requires justification of my particular situation.
